Agreed Position Statement on Bus Services

1. This agreed position statement has been prepared by Vectos, on behalf of Places for People (PfP) & City and Provincial Properties (CPP), in respect of the proposed Site Allocation and delivery of a residential-led mixed use development at the Gilston Area.
2. The signatories to this statement are Vectos and Arriva.
 - Vectos is PfP and CPP's appointed transport planning consultants;
 - Arriva is a multinational public transport company, and are the main bus operator within Harlow.
3. This agreed position statement sets out matters related to bus services.
4. The following is agreed:
 - A development of 10,000 homes at the Gilston Area has the potential to support the commercial operation of a frequent bus service (i.e. with a frequency of at least one service every 10 minutes);
 - A combination of extended and new bus services can connect the Gilston Area to Harlow Town Station, Harlow Town Centre, Employment Zones in Harlow, and other local towns and villages;
 - PfP, CPP and Arriva will work together to ensure that the Gilston Area has a good bus service throughout the phased development of the site;
